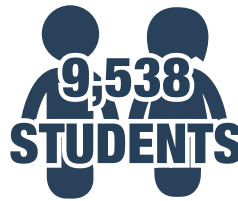

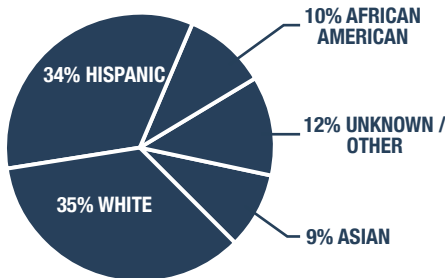

STEM TALENT PLUS

The College of Arts and Sciences offers undergraduate majors and minors and master's degrees in over 60 fields of intellectual inquiry, scientific research, creative expression, and social engagement.

Today's workforce must be equipped with the knowledge and skills to solve tough problems, gather/evaluate evidence, and make sense of information. These are STEM skills that students learn by studying Science, Technology, Engineering, and Math.

HR DEVELOPMENT

The Department of Literacy, Leadership, and Development offers Human Resource Development (HRD) programs for both undergraduate and graduate degrees, and a minor.

These programs train effective leaders and change agents and prepare students for strategic leadership positions in educational and corporate organizations.

A 9-credit HRD internship and seminar will be the culminating activity for the Human Resource Development major and will provide experience in health care settings, business and industry, community, state and federal agencies, rehabilitation and recreation centers, and professional associations.
